

Co-operation Agreement
between
the International Society of Electrochemistry
and
the Electrochemistry Group of the French Society of Chemistry (SCF)

Preamble

In view of the increasing participation of the electrochemical community in France, which is represented by the Electrochemistry Group of the French Society of Chemistry (SFC), in the activities of the International Society of Electrochemistry (ISE), and of the contacts between both Societies in the last years, it is intended to intensify the co-operation in the future. This agreement refers especially to an exchange of information, and occasionally to the organization of common or sponsored meetings.

1. Exchange of information

Both societies will inform each other on actual and future activities. The President of the Electrochemistry Group of the French Society of Chemistry (SFC) will be the representative who is responsible for the exchange of information, and for the contacts with ISE. This representative may participate as a guest at the Meeting of the Regional Representatives of the ISE.

2. Announcement of meetings

It is in the interest of both societies to announce their meetings appropriately in the publications of the co-operating society. The Electrochemistry Group of the French Society of Chemistry (SFC) will be able to announce its meetings in the Electrochemistry Calendar on the ISE website, while ISE will be able to announce its meetings in the publications and in the website of the SFC.

3. Advertisements at meetings

Advertisements at meetings of the co-operating society, e.g. in the form of a poster are welcome.

4. Co-operation on Internet

Internet links between the websites of the societies will be installed.

5. Term of the Agreement

This agreement shall enter into force upon execution by both parties and shall remain valid for an initial period of three (3) years. Thereafter it shall be automatically extended for a period of one year unless terminated by either party to the end of the initial period, or to the end of any extension period by giving at least 3 months prior written notice to the other party.
